### **KOSHER SUMMIT**



In an effort to enhance and improve the kosher diet for Jewish inmates in Illinois, Rabbi Binyomin Scheiman, Director of the Hinda Institute held a meeting with Rabbi Mendy Katz, the head of prison advocacy, Rabbi Bentzi Geisinsky from the Aleph Institute and staff from the Illinois Department of Corrections (IDOC), including the Chief Chaplain, directors, chief dietary staff and legal staff. After receiving grievances from the incarcerated in Illinois, it was decided to standardize the kosher


diet statewide. Rabbi Scheiman explained; "the integrity of kosher standards is a critical issue". The meeting's results are: 1) questionnaires will be sent out to survey institutional policies 2) Hinda Institute chaplains will make onsite visits to institutional kitchens. The findings will generate recommendations to develop a written state-wide policy for Illinois. Rabbi Scheiman said: "The goal is simple, the IDOC kosher program should be the envy of state prison programs nationwide".

# Home Run for Ber! New Safe House!

In June 2021, the Hinda Institute opened a nicely furnished safe house to eliminate the difficulty of those who are reentering society, who are on registry and who need to find housing. Landlords are reluctant to rent to anyone with a record or a poor financial history. Sometimes this means that our clients can't leave the institution even when they finish their restitution. It often means that they become homeless. It is hard to find employment when you have no address. This safe house has already assisted 3 people. Our clients love having a place where they can close the door and feel safe. We watch over them. It is so successful that we are looking to fund another safe house.

Our latest guest Ber, a really sweet guy, has known the Rabbi for over 30 years. He heroically has been battling an addiction to heroin. Upon his release he was ok, then felt overconfident and "the demons" overtook him. Ber hit an all-time low. He tried to take his own life. Fortunately, he failed. A Hinda Institute caseworker stayed with him, talked him through the overdose throughout the night and walked him by phone to S. Joseph Hospital, then to Loretta Hospital where he painfully detoxed. A Jewish soul was saved.

Ber asked Rabbi Scheiman to visit him. Rabbi Scheiman said;" He was in a lot of pain. Sometimes

people need to hit an all-time low before they can rebuild their lives." Our caseworkers found him immediate employment. Now Ber attends our addiction support group. He joins us for the holidays, we call him and we are hiring a trauma expert to further assist him. He attends Narcotics Anonymous meetings. Most importantly, he is rebuilding his life in our safe house.

Ber attests; "I've been home since May and have had my share of turmoil. The Hinda Institute has been there for me every step of the way. I am currently living in what's called the "safe house", which has brought me peace of mind and tranquility which I never had upon my release. I am forever grateful to the Hinda Institute. They have helped me with and continue to help me on a daily basis. The safe house gives me a place where I can not only collect my thoughts and find peace, but a place where I feel safe and not in anybody's way. I feel like I have a support system that will help me through this transition that has been so difficult for me in the past."

Ber is fighting, but he now has a wining chance. Our caseworkers and our safe house have played a crucial role. Ber has ambitions to study social work. Where there is life, there is always hope. When there is a safe place to live, there is an oasis. When there is a Jewish soul, we can't give up. (This story is reprinted with permission.)
